

REGISTRATION OF UGANDANS STRANDED IN NIGERIA, GHANA, TOGO, IVORY COAST, BENIN, SENEGAL, BURKINA FASO, EQUATORIAL GUINEA, REPUBLIC OF GUINEA, LIBERIA, THE GAMBIA, NIGER, MALI, SIERRA LEONE, GUINEA BISSAU AND CAPE VERDE

Fellow Ugandans,

Uganda High Commission in Abuja, Nigeria is verifying and registering all Ugandans presently in the Mission's area of accreditation i.e. Nigeria, Ghana, Togo, Ivory Coast, Benin, Senegal, Burkina Faso, Equatorial Guinea, Republic Of Guinea, Liberia, The Gambia, Niger, Mali, Sierra Leone, Guinea Bissau and Cape Verde, and who planned to travel or where en-route home but were held in their current respective locations because of the Coronavirus outbreak which leads to Covid-19 disease.

While this registration excludes Ugandans with confirmed/settled migration status in the above named countries, it nonetheless includes students who completed their studies and were destined to return to Uganda and all those even when not students, were on short term visit in the said countries and non-immigrant visa holders of all categories whose travel plans were disrupted by boarder closures.

Should you fall in the above category, kindly send all your details to Uganda High Commission in Abuja indicating:

1. Who you are (a brief about yourself and full names)
2. Home and workplace address in Uganda
3. Copy of the Bio-data page of your Ugandan Passport
4. Copy of your National Identity Card
5. Details of your current physical address and your e mail address
6. Copy of the return air ticket, if applicable
7. Scanned page with the visa of the host country and where applicable scanned documents of sponsoring institution.
